

Addition to The Wandering Scots

Edna Manning Laughter discovered a letter written on April 26, 1970 to her mother, Edna Rear Manning, from the first Stuart Barclay MacMillan, the son of Joseph Ellsworth MacMillan (#1489) and the grandson of John MacMillan (#1459).

The following information should have appeared in The Wandering Scots on page 149.

Stuart's parents were **Joseph Ellsworth MacMillan** and **Emma Florence Knowles**. They were married in Newmarket, Ontario and moved to California in 1899. They had the following children:

- i. **Joseph Ellsworth MacMillan** was born October 22, 1924
- ii. **Stuart Barclay MacMillan Jr.** was born September 5, 1927
- iii. **Mary Louise MacMillan** was born November 4, 1925
- iv. **M_____ Stacy MacMillan** was born September 9, 1935.
